In view of the above submission of learned counsel for the State, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation for redressal of her grievances before the respondent No.3 along with a copy of this order within a week from today. On such representation being made, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondent No.3 in accordance with law on its own merits within a further period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.
