Municipal Corporation, Durg & Anr. reported in 2006(II) MPJR-CG 96, which has been disposed of vide order dated 3.4.2006 and the order dated 7.2.2007 passed by this Court in W.P.(s) No.697 of 2007 (A.N.V. Satyanarayan and others Vs. State of Chhattisgarh and others).</p> <p>Accordingly, the writ petition is allowed in terms of the order passed in the case of Yashwant Kumar Bharadwaj (supra) and A.N.V. Satyanarayan (supra), subject to verification of the fact as to whether the petitioners have acquired B.Ed./D.Ed./B.T.I./M.Ed. Examination certificate on their own expenses, as per the circulars dated 13.9.1974, 24.12.1998 and 1.3.1999 and further, whether they have been paid two advance increments or not.
