**ORAL ORDER**

1. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that as per direction of the Supreme Court, the Caste Scrutiny Committee is required to call for vigilance report. The petitioner has obtained a copy of the vigilance report dated 29.12.2005, which indicates that the petitioner belongs to Gond tribe community. The petitioner further submits that in view of the vigilance report, the Caste Scrutiny Committee is not required to proceed further.
2. Be that as it may. The petitioner may approach the Caste Scrutiny Committee for taking appropriate steps under the provisions of law.
3. With the above observations, this petition stands disposed of. No order as to costs.
