ORAL ORDER

(Passed on this 30th day of June, 2008)

- Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the
 retiral benefits of the petitioner were due on 31st August, 2000.
 The same were paid after a period of one year and two months.
 Thus, the petitioner is entitled to interest on the delayed payment
 of the amount.
- Learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.2/Municipal Corporation submits, it appears that the petitioner has not vacated the official accommodation, allotted to him.
- 3. Be that as it may, as requested by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the petitioner is granted liberty to make a representation to the concerned authority for appropriate relief. In the event, such a representation is made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided, on its own merits, in





accordance with law, as early as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.

4. With the above observation, this petition stands disposed of. No costs.
