ORAL ORDER

1.      Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the  
retiral benefits of the petitioner were due on 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2000.  
The same were paid after a period of one year and two months.  
Thus, the petitioner is entitled to interest on the delayed payment  
of the amount.
2.      Learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.2/Municipal  
Corporation submits, it appears that the petitioner has not vacated  
the official accommodation, allotted to him.
3.      Be that as it may, as requested by learned counsel appearing for  
the petitioner, the petitioner is granted liberty to make a  
representation to the concerned authority for appropriate relief.  
In the event, such a representation is made by the petitioner, the  
same shall be considered and decided, on its own merits, in

accordance with law, as early as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.
