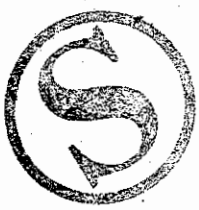

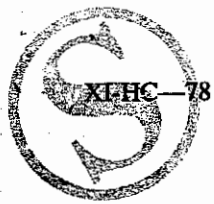

	<p>Learned counsel for the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2 submits that in compliance of the order of this Court a sum of Rs.1,30,000/- has been deposited by the petitioner. However, the same has not been disbursed by the Commissioner for Workmen Compensation.</p> <p>The petitioner has no objection if the above amount is disbursed to the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2.</p> <p>Accordingly, the application dated 14.11.2007 is allowed and it is directed that the above amount deposited by the petitioner shall be disbursed to the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2 forthwith.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted a proposal for making payment in installments of the awarded sum. It is submitted that she may be allowed to deposit the awarded sum before the Commissioner for Workmen Compensation on a monthly installment of Rs.30,000/-.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2 submits that the above proposal is acceptable to the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2.</p>

	<p>In view of above, the instant petition is disposed of in the following terms:-</p> <p>(i) that the petitioner shall deposit the first installment of Rs.30,000/- on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2008 and thereafter she shall deposit the subsequent installments at the rate of 30,000/- per month by 5<sup>th</sup> of every month with the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation, Labour Court, Ambikapur (CG); who, in turn, shall disburse the same to the respondents No. 1 &amp; 2 forthwith;</p> <p>(ii) if the petitioner makes any default in paying the installments, the whole awarded amount shall be recoverable from the petitioner by way of execution proceedings.</p>
