ORAL JUDGMENT

When the matter is taken up for final hearing,
 Mr. Joshi learned Counsel appearing for the

petitioner states that as per his client, the reference under Sick Industrial Companies (Special Provisions) Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as ('SICA Act') was pending on the date, when the earlier appeal/revision decided, and also on the date, when the review application was heard and is pending, even as on now. However, he states that as the tribunal is yet to decide all the question of merits, and as revision is to be heard by the tribunal, the petitioner is not pressing this petition at this stage.

- 1. Mr. Majmudar learned Counsel appearing for the respondent submitted that tribunal may be directed to decide the revision application within some reasonable time.
- 2. Under these circumstances, the petition is disposed of as not pressed. Rule is discharged. IR, if any, is vacated.
- 3. It is observed that tribunal shall make an attempt to dispose of revision as early as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the receipt of the order.

4. It would be open to both the sides, to raise contention as available in law including provisions of Section 22 of the SICA Act.
