- 1. Heard Mr.V.D.Sathe, learned counsel for the appellant.
- 2. The respondents have applied for withdrawal of the amount deposited in the court. The compromise order passed by the Lok-adalat shows that the respondents are entitled to sum of Rs.2,60,000/- only and the Insurance Company is entitled to receive back a sum of Rs.76000/-. Therefore, the final claim i.e. decree in favour of the respondents is Rs.2,60,000/-. They would be entitled to total sum of Rs.2,60,000/- plus interest thereon. They have already been paid Rs.

1,50,000/-, therefore they would now be entitled to sum of Rs.1,10,000/- and interest thereon. Since it appears that a large sum has already been paid, it would not be desirable to pay the sum of Rs.1,10,000/-. This sum of Rs.1,10,000/- has to be deposited in the name of claimant nos.1 and 2 in a Nationalized Bank. The Claimant Nos.1 and 2 alone would be entitled to receive interest thereon. The claimant no.3 to 5 have already become major and their share has already been given in equal sum when sum of Rs.1,50,000/ was paid. The application is, therefore, rejected.

The insurance Company be paid Rs.76000/-back along with interest thereon from out of sum of Rs. 4,44,679/- deposited in the court.
