**ORDER**

Petitioner who was the 5<sup>th</sup> accused in Crime No. 128 of 2002 of Nenmara Police Station for offences punishable under Sections 143, 147 and 353 read with Section 149 I.P.C. and whose case was split up from C.C. No. 58 of 2003 on the file of the Judl. First Class Magistrate, Alathur and re-filed as C.C. 349 of 2007 and against whom non-bailable warrants of arrest are pending, seeks to quash the proceedings in C.C. No. 349 of 2007 on the ground that co-accused in the case were acquitted after trial as per Annexure I judgment dated 26-07-2007 in C.C. 58 of 2003.

2. In the light of the decision of the Full Bench in **Moosa v. Sub Inspector of Police - 2006 (1) KLT 552**, this Court cannot look into Annexure - I Judgment so as to quash the proceedings against the petitioner without a trial. Hence, the proper course the petitioner would be plead for a discharge.

Accordingly, this Crl.M.C. is disposed of permitting the petitioner to surrender before the Magistrate and to file a

petition for regular bail within two weeks from today. In case the petitioner complies with this condition, the learned Magistrate shall release the petitioner on bail on appropriate conditions and shall permit the petitioner to plead for a discharge in the light of the fact that the co-accused in the case have been acquitted after trial.
