**JUDGMENT**

The short grievance of the petitioner is that no proper investigation is being conducted into Crime Nos.701 of 2005 and 214, 221, 222 & 223 of 2006 of Kalady Police in spite of the direction issued by this Court in Ext.P7 common judgment dated 07.02.07.

The learned Government Pleader after taking instructions submits that there is no substance in the grievance in as much as final reports have already been filed by the Investigating Officer in all the 5 cases. The learned Magistrate has taken cognizance on the basis of those final reports and the cases are pending as C.C.Nos.1667 of 2007, 191, 192, 193 & 194 of 2008. In the light of this submission of the learned Government Pleader, the learned counsel for the petitioner does not seek any further directions in this Writ Petition.

3. This Writ Petition is, in these circumstances, dismissed as agreed.
