J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is a retired employee of the Kerala State Road Transport Corporation. The petitioner's grievance in this writ petition is that he has not been paid arrears of pay revision and terminal leave surrender salary. Detailing this grievance he has already submitted Ext.P3 representation before the respondent. The petitioner submits that in view of Ext.P2 decision of the Division Bench of this Court, the petitioner has become entitled to arrears of pay revision.

2. I have heard the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the KSRTC also.

3. In the facts and circumstances of the case, I dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondent to consider and pass orders on Ext.P3 as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment, after affording an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner. It would be open to the petitioner to rely on Ext.P2 or any other judgment or material in support of his case,
