## **JUDGMENT**

The petitioner is a participant and team leader of a stage event 'Margamkali' staged in St. Mary's Girls High School, Payyannur. The petitioner's team was placed only 3<sup>rd</sup> A Grade. The petitioner seeks for a direction to permit her and her team to participate in the 49<sup>th</sup> Kerala Kalolsavam 2008-2009. Mainly it is contended that the judges who judged the event were not qualified.

2. Learned Govt. Pleader on instructions, submits that the petitioner was only placed 3<sup>rd</sup> A Grade and the difference is 20 marks. In such circumstances, this court will not be sitting in appeal over the decisions of the appellate authority. I find no merit in the writ petition. It is accordingly dismissed.
