Petitioner is the wife of the 3rd respondent. They have also

one child by name Kalidas. The writ petition is filed alleging the

detention of the child illegally by the 3rd and 4th respondents. Pursuant

to the notice issued by this court the parties were present before us on

two occasions. The child was also produced. The petitioner was

permitted to mingle with the child. It is seen that the child is not in

the illegal custody. The child is with the father, the 3rd respondent.

According to the 3rd respondent it is the petitioner who left the

matrimonial home leaving the child with the father. In the above

circumstances we do not think that any further orders are required in

this writ petition. The 3^{rd} and 4^{th} respondents have agreed that it will

be open to the petitioner to go over to their house at any time and in

fact they have requested the petitioner to be with them and be with

her husband and their child.
