J U D G M E N T

The Claimants have filed this appeal seeking enhancement of compensation in a case of fatal accident. In the appeal, a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- is claimed towards enhanced compensation.

2. Both the counsel on instructions from their respective parties, arrived at consensus and filed a memo stating that the award of the Tribunal can be enhanced to a further sum of Rs.60,000/- in full quit. The said Memorandum reads as follows:

"By consent, it is submitted that as against the claim for enhancement of Rs.1,00,000/- in the appeal, award of the Tribunal may be enhanced by Rs.60,000/- in full quit payable by 2nd respondent within six weeks from the date of receipt of the order."

3. The consent memo is recorded. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of in terms of consent memo. The consent memo will be form and part of the decree.

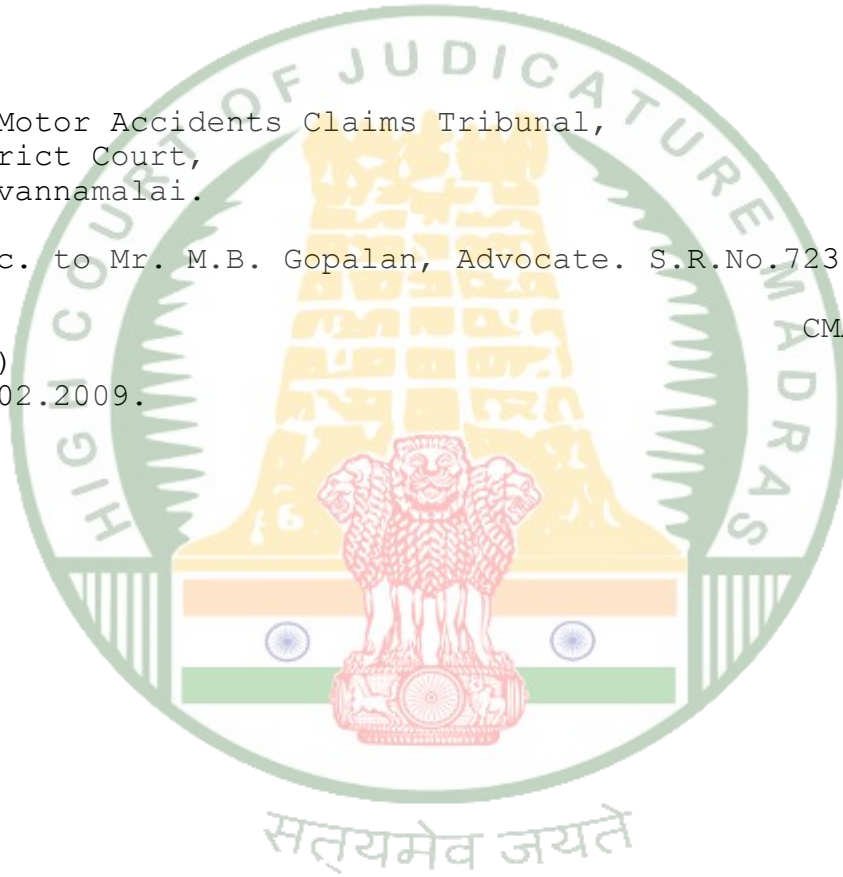
