The Court made the following:

Judgment: (Per Hon'ble The Chief Justice Sri Anil R. Dave)

This appeal is filed against an interim order, without joining a party from whom increment has been prayed for. In the circumstances, in our opinion, the appeal fails for non-joinder of necessary party.

It is pertinent to note that though the employer has been joined in the writ petition as party respondent, for the reasons best known to the appellant, employer has not been joined in the present appeal.

In view of the fact that the very writ petition has been fixed for hearing on 23-06-2008, in our opinion, this appeal need not be entertained and more particularly for the reason that the prayer made in this writ appeal is beyond the scope of the petition.

Appeal is accordingly dismissed.
