The controversy, as to the right of the respondents to insist on payment of rentals, was the subject matter of various writ petitions and writ appeals over the past few years. It is represented that a Division Bench of this Court has stipulated the manner, in which the respondents can recover the arrears.

Therefore, the writ petition is disposed of, leaving it open to the respondents to follow the procedure, which is now in vogue. There shall be no order as to costs.
