Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the Affidavit filed herein the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, declaring the impugned proceedings of the 1st respondent in Lr.No.150/A3/07 dt. 8.5.2008 and in Lr.No.150/A3/07 dt. 22.9.2008 in not issuing the equivalence certificate to the petitioner for eligibility to admission into 4 year B.Sc. Nursing Course in 2nd respondent institution as totally unfair, arbitrary, illegal, without jurisdiction and in violation of Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same by further directing the Respondents to continue the petitioner in the B.Sc. Nursing 4 year course in the 2nd respondent college by granting necessary equivalence certificate and to pass such other order or further orders in the interest of justice.
