## THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE V.ESWARAIAH WRIT PETITION No.1646 of 2008

**ORDER:** 

It is the case of the petitioners that they made a representation before the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent on 15-10-2007 stating that their grand father late Shri S.B.Dhannu Singh @ Dhannaiah was assigned patta lands by the Nizam's Government in Sy.Nos.1200 to 2200 situated at Lingareddypally village, Siddipet Town, Medak District, during the period from 1930 to 1950. But, however, they lost original patta certificates. Therefore, they requested the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to furnish certified copies of phaisal patti, chowfasla and pahanies from the year 1930 to 1974 under Section 6 of the Information Act, 2005. It is further stated that the petitioners also made a representation before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent on 06-10-2007 seeking similar relief. Accordingly, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent through proceedings in L.Dis.No.A4/11118/2007, dated 20-12-2007, requested the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to take immediate necessary action on the contents of the petition within the stipulated time and furnish information to the petitioners.

A perusal of the representations made before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent as well as the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent do not disclose any particulars about the identity of the lands in Sy.Nos.1200 to 2200. As the representations filed by the petitioners are vague and bereft of any material particulars, the question of directing the respondents to furnish certified copies of pahanies in Sy.Nos.1200 to 2200 does not arise. Therefore, the writ petition is misconceived and not maintainable and the same is liable to be dismissed.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
