MAHESH GROVER, J

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that if one opportunity is granted to him, he will adduce his entire evidence without any failing.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and even though finding that the impugned order is perfectly justified, I am of the considered opinion that ends of justice could be served if the petitioner is granted one opportunity to lead his entire evidence.

Petition is disposed of without issuance of notice of motion as resorting to this process is likely to delay the proceedings further and also keeping in view the fact that equitable justice can be ensured by compensating the other side with costs.

Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioner is accepted. One effective opportunity shall be afforded to the petitioner by the learned Trial Court to adduce his entire evidence without fail.

Thus, the impugned order is set aside and the revision petition is accepted, however, subject to payment of Rs. 5,000/- as costs.
