Petitioner Jagdish Singh has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuing direction to the respondents to issue him a Red Card as per the State Government Policy, as the petitioner is victim of 1984 riots.

Before approaching this Court, the petitioner made a representation (Annexure P-3) for the necessary relief, but till date, no action has been taken by the respondents on the prayer made by the petitioner.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner and without issuing notice of motion, as it will un-necessary delay the proceedings, we dispose

of this writ petition with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the claim of the petitioner in accordance with law and if the petitioner is found to be not entitled for the relief claimed by him, then a speaking order shall be passed in this regard.
