The petitioner was a candidate for the post of Lecturer in the

subject of Political Science (guest faculty). By making reference to the

Policy Statement (Annexure P/1), counsel for the petitioner states that the

petitioner belongs to the same village where post was to be filed up.

Despite that his claim has wrongly been rejected and respondent No.5 has

been appointed in a very arbitrary manner.

At the time of arguments, it was brought to our notice that by

stating his grievance, the petitioner has already sent a representation

(application) dated 22.8.2007 (Annexure P/2), which is still pending

undecided.

In view of facts of this case, without expressing any opinion on

merits, we dispose of this writ petition by issuing directions to respondent

No.2 to treat this writ petition as a representation and decide the same as per

law, by passing a speaking order. Needful be done within a period of two

weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order along with

copy of the writ petition. If it is found that appointment of respondent No.5 was not justified, after giving notice to him, it be quashed and the petitioner be appointed in his place.

Copy of the order be given dasti on payment of usual charges.
