**ASHUTOSH MOHUNTA, J.(ORAL)** 

The petitioner joined Rajputana Rifles as Infantry Soldier on 29.5.1976. He was discharged from service on his request on compassionate grounds on 16.5.1980. The petitioner rejoined the Army DSC on 7.9.1982. The petitioner while serving with 30 DSC Platoon attached to Air Force Station Adampur developed a disease of Neurosis (Hysteria). He was downgraded to low medical category 'EEE'. A invaliding medical board was held. In pursuance to the findings of the medical board, the petitioner was invalided out from service. The petitioner claimed disability pension and sent a letter to the authorities which was rejected. The petitioner preferred an appeal which was also rejected by the MOD vide order dated 8.12.1986.

The petitioner has challenged the rejection of his appeal dated 8.12.1986, although the said order has not been placed on record.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is entitled to be granted disability pension as he developed the disease while in service.
