The claim of the petitioner is for recording of mutation in the revenue record, in terms of the Will dated 20.04.2008(Annexure P1) executed by Ajaib Singh in favour of the petitioner. The revenue courts have presently ordered the land to be mutated in the name of all the legal heirs falling in Class-I. Before the claim of the petitioner can be accepted, it would be imperative for the petitioner to seek a determination in connection with the authenticity of the Will dated 20.04.2008 from a civil Court of competent jurisdiction.

Accordingly, we consider it just and appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to seek authenticity of the Will dated 20.04.2008 (Annexure P-1) from a civil Court of competent jurisdiction. As and when the civil Court authenticates the Will in question, the final determination rendered by the civil Court will be entered

in the revenue record by effecting a proper mutation thereof.

The instant writ Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
