The petitioner, who was Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat Village Jallah, District Ludhiana, has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the letter dated 6.3.2007 (Annexure P-1), issued by Special Secretary Planning, Government of Punjab, Department of Planning to all the Deputy Commissioners as well as the letter dated 8.4.2007 issued by Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Block Doraha, District Ludhiana, respondent No.3 herein, whereby the petitioner has been ordered to hand over the grants sanctioned to the Gram Panchayat to respondent No.3.

In the written statement, it has been mentioned that the amount

so withdrawn will be re-allocated to the Executive Agencies according to

the procedure now adopted by the Government. Mr. N.D.S. Mann,

Additional Advocate General, Punjab, states that whatsoever amount has

been utilized that will not be taken back and the remaining unutilized

amount will be re-allocated as per the scheme.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that since the term of the

petitioner has expired and new Sarpanch has been elected on the

constitution of new Gram Panchayat, therefore, at this stage, the petitioner

does not want to pursue this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, it will be open for the Gram Panchayat or its office

bearers to pursue with the Government with regard to re-allocation of the

amount under the said scheme.
