Urgency application is allowed.

2. Heard.

3. By means of this writ petition, the petitioners have sought writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the advertisement dated 29.12.2007 whereby the recruitment process of filling vacancies of Sub-Inspectors/Platoon commanders is initiated.

4. The ground challenging the impugned recruitment is that malpractices adopted in the earlier recruitment process of 2001-2002 is still subjudice before the Division Bench of this Court wherein the petitioners are the appellants. From the papers on record, it appears that some 253 vacancies of the Sub-Inspector/Platoon Commanders are to be filled through the impugned selection process, which does not include the vacancies filled by the recruitment of 2001-2002. As such this Court does not find any sufficient reason to interfere with the impugned recruitment process on the ground mentioned in this writ petition.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed in-limine.
