The matter was put up before the Lok Adalat.

The claimants as well as the New India Assurance Company have settled the claim before the Lok Adalat as per compromise deed, attached with the order. According to the compromise deed the New India Assurance Company Ltd. has agreed to pay a sum of Rs. 30,000/- over and above the awarded amount without any interest on this enhanced amount. The claimants have accepted the aforesaid amount.

Therefore, the appeal is disposed of in terms of compromise attached with this order. The compromise deed shall form part of the decree.

The amount of compensation (including the statutory amount), if any, deposited before this Court, shall be remitted to the Tribunal concerned.
