Urgency application is allowed.

2. Heard.

3. By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has sought writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned transfer order dated 31.12.2007 passed by respondent No. 1 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Uttarkashi to Tehri Garhwal.

4. The notices on behalf of respondents are accepted by Sri Vipul Sharma holding brief of Sri Rakesh Thapliyal, Advocate. He is also heard.

5. The copy of the impugned order which is annexed as annexure No. 1 to the writ petition shows that the impugned transfer order is passed in the public

interest. Apart from this para – 8 of the writ petition shows that the petitioner has been already relieved on 04.01.2008 in pursuance to the impugned transfer order, a copy of which is annexed as annexure No. 2 to the writ petition.

6. In these circumstances, this court is not inclined to interfere with the impugned transfer order and this petition is liable to be dismissed.

7. Therefore, the petition is dismissed with the observation that the petitioner may make a representation to the authorities concerned for redressal of his grievances, which shall be disposed of, by such authorities within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order along with the representation.
