The short controversy raised by the petitioners in this writ petition is that though a prayer was made to the appellate court for passing of interim order in favour of the petitioners but the said prayer was not accepted hence, a direction is sought that during the pendency of appeal, a direction may be given to the effect that both the parties should maintain status-quo.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that if a direction of status-quo till the disposal of the appeal is given, he has no objection.

Looking to the aforesaid accordingly, a direction is given to both the parties to maintain status-quo as existing today and court below is directed to decide the appeal within a period of two months from today.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
