The petitioner has challenged the order dated 18.7.2007 by which the interim maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C. has been awarded to the wife @ Rs.1500/- p.m. and to the two children respondent No.3 and 4 @ Rs.750/- p.m.

So far as the order under Section 125 Cr.P.C. awarding interim maintenance is concerned I am not inclined to interfere with the same. The said order is subject to the final order that may be passed by the learned Magistrate after the evidence has been lead by both the parties and after due consideration of the same.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed. The stay petition also stands dismissed.

The learned counsel for the petitioners prays that a direction may be issued to the learned Magistrate to decide the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. expeditiously.

In the facts and circumstances it is

hereby directed that the learned Magistrate shall with the co-operation of both the parties take steps to decide the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. expeditiously, preferably within 18 months of the submission of the certified copy of this order.
