Delay in filing this appeal is condoned.

The matter pertains to appointment of the writ petitioners on the post of Teacher Grade-III pursuant to the advertisement dated 11.4.2005. The Learned Single Judge of this Court allowed the writ applications interpreting the circular of the State Government dated 20.9.2005 and held that the writ petitioners should not be asked to complete the training before the appointment and accordingly, directed the State authorities to consider the writ petitioners for their appointment in the light of the circular aforesaid.

From the circular, as quoted by the Learned Single Judge of this Court, it appears that for certain categories as specified in the circular, they can be appointed even without training, subject to completion of training within three years of the appointment.

In view of the circular of the State Government, the writ petitioners could have been considered as per directions of this Court.

This appeal, in this view of the matter, does not merit any consideration. It is accordingly dismissed.
