Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

According to the learned counsel for the petitioners it was
Chaukidar whose brother is the informant of the instant case who is
behind filing of the case; otherwise he was opposing for establishment
of a police picket in the village. The allegation of theft is super added
allegation that is also against Vijay who is not the petitioner and no
case under Section 307 of the Penal Code is made out as only
informant's neck was pressed but no any sign of injury was found by
the doctor.

In the suggested facts and circumstances, this petition for
anticipatory bail is allowed. In case of arrest or surrender within one
month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order in
Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S.Case No.190/2009, the above named
petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten thousand)each with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial

Magistrate, Sherghati, Gaya, subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section (2) of Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
