Let Abdul Barik, son of Md. Arif be impleaded as petitioner no.3 in the instant case.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with a case registered for the offence under Section 498A of the Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. It is submitted on behalf of Abdul Barik, the husband of the complainant that he is ready and willing to continue the matrimonial relationship with the complainant and for that purpose he shall file written undertaking on affidavit within a period of four weeks from today.

Once such undertaking on affidavit is filed petitioners above named be admitted to the privilege of provisional bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5000/- (Five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Complaint Case No. 955C of 2007 thereafter notice be issued to the complainant and once she appears petitioner no.3 Abdul Barik in presence of the court persuade her to come back to the matrimonial fold not only by words of mouth but

also by his suitable conduct and gesture.

In the event, matrimonial dispute is resolved or the complainant comes back to the matrimonial fold or she is found to be unreasonable, provisional bail granted to the petitioners be confirmed, failing which the court below shall pass appropriate orders in accordance with law considering the reasonableness of the stand of the parties.

This application is, accordingly, disposed of.
