Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, State and the Accountant General.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the father of the petitioner was paid the pension till death i.e. on 18th of December 1994. Petitioner learnt that the pension was revised with effect from 1st of March 1989, as such, the father of the petitioner was required to be paid the arrears on account of such revision.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of State submits that petitioner has approached this court after inordinate delay.

The line the above circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for expeditious disposal of his claims, petitioner proposes to file a representation before the respondent no. 3 enclosing the copy of the relevant documents if any, in support of such claim along with certified copy of the present order within a period of six weeks from today.

In case such representation is filed, the respondent no. 3 shall consider each of the claims raised by the petitioner in his representation in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months on receipt of such representation so that the pending claims of the petitioner could be settled without delay.

The writ application is disposed of with the above observations/directions.
