Learned counsel for the petitioner

is present. A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the State and also on behalf of the Accountant General.

After some argument, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of the grievance, petitioner has already filed a representation dated 15.10.2008 to the District Superintendent of Education, Rohtas with a copy to the Accountant General. However, the representation has remained pending till date since petitioner has not heard nothing after filing of the representation. Notwithstanding

the above for expeditious disposal of the claim, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner propose to file a fresh representation before the respondent no.3. In case, such representation is filed within a period of four weeks along with the certified copy of the represent order, the respondent no.3 shall consider the grievance of the petitioner in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within three months of receipt of such representation.

This writ application is disposed of with above observations and directions.
