Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners who are the family members of the husband apprehend arrest in a complaint case under Sections 306, 498A and 406 of the Penal Code.

Petitioner nos. 3,4, and 5 are stated to be the wife of the brother of the husband while the latter two are the grandfather and mother-in-law. Let the petitioners 3, 4 and 5 abovenamed surrender in the Court below within a period of six weeks from today when they shall be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/-(twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Complaint Case No. 627 / (c)/2007, T.R. No. 2520 of 2007, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.

The husband of the alleged victim is stated to be still absconding. After he subjects himself to the law, petitioner nos. 1 and 2 who are mother-in-law and brother-in-law, if so advised may renew the prayer for bail before the Court below.

The application is rejected with regard to them.
