2. 30.11.2009 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offence under Section 366A of the Indian Penal Code.

Taking into consideration the fact that the first information report was instituted three months after the occurrence which appears to suggest that in fact the victim girl and the present petitioner had married out of their own sweet will but later on she turned turtle probably on the coercion of the parents and has given incriminating statement u/s.164 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner, let the petitioner above named, who is in custody since 22.6.2009, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- (Five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Patna in connection with Kankarbagh P.S.case No.169 of 2009, subject to the conditions (i) that one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner and (ii) that the petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse.
