Heard learned Counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in a police case under Sections 304B & 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegations are for demand of dowry within seven years and disposal of the dead body in an unnatural manner without intimation to the parents. The defence is of subsequent compromise.

The application is rejected in so far as petitioner Nos.1 and 2 above named are concerned.

Considering the status of petitioner no.3, the wife of the brother of the husband, situated herself in the position of a daughter-in-law like the deceased with generalized allegation, let her surrender within a period of four weeks before the Court below, when she shall be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai in Surajgarha ( Kajra) P.S. case No. 43 of 2009, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
