Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in Sikandra P.S. Case No. 131 of 2007 for the offences under Section 307 and other sections of the Indian Penal Code. As per the First Information Report it is apparent that the feud is between Gotia with regard to filling of a well. In the fact of injuries having been found, I am not inclined to entertain this application. In so far as petitioner No.2, Sanoj Tanti is concerned, he may surrender before the Court below and seek regular bail which will deal with in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.

So far as petitioner No.1, Manoj Tanti and Petitioner No.3, Pappu Tanti are concerned, they have neither armed nor attacked on informant as averred and ascribed in the F.I.R.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the petitioner No.1, Manoj Tanti and Petitioner No.3, Pappu Tanti, shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Jammui in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No.131/07, subject to all conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
