The petitioner, Ramautar Yadav, who though not named in the F.I.R., finds himself incarcerated in connection with Lakhisarai Kabaiya P.S. Case No.91 of 2006 registered under Section 394 I.P.C. against unknown.

Apart from the petitioner not being named in the F.I.R., he has not been put on T.I. Parade nor any incriminating articles have been recovered from his possession.

It appears that the petitioner was arrested in connection with Lakhisarai Kabaiya P.S. Case No.296 of 2007 and he is said to have confessed his participation in the instant case.

It is by now well settled that self inculpatory statements have no value in the eye of law.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner, Ramautar Yadav, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Presiding Judge, Fast Track Court No.I, Lakhisarai in connection with Sessions Case No.623 of

2008 arising out of Lakhisarai Kabaiya P.S. Case No.91 of 2006.
