Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Raj Nagar P.S. Case No. 126/2007 for offence under Sections 341, 384, 379 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There is specific allegation against the petitioners that they demanded Rangdari from the informant and when the demand was not fulfilled they assaulted the informant and injured from the butt of revolver.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Petitioner No. 1 filed a case against the informant and in retaliation the present case has been filed against them.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the nature of the case, I am not inclined to allow prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Hence prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners is accordingly rejected.
