Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case instituted for the offences under sections 341, 323, 307 and 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Taking into consideration the fact that there was land dispute between the parties on account of which the occurrence of assault took place for which two cases were filed one on each side and there is no specific overt act against the petitioners, let the petitioners above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5,000/— each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kishanganj in connection with Thakurganj (Galgalia) P.S. Case No.130 of 2009 subject to the following conditions:

- (a) that one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioners who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioners,
- (b) that the petitioners will give an undertaking that they will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on the date fixed for charge and if they fail to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, their bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse.
