Mr. Sharda Nand Mishra appears for the petitioner.

There is no representation on behalf of the Zila Parishad, Banka.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition for payment of his retiral benefits having retired from the services of the Zila Parishad, Banka with effect from 30.9.2004 from the post of Assistant in the Zila Parishad.

Learned counsel submits that the matter is pending since 2005 and the petitioner has not received his retiral benefits.

Despite issuance of notice, none appears for the Zila Parishad.

In the circumstances, no useful purpose would be served in keeping this writ petition pending. This writ petition is thus disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before the respondent no. 2, the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-the Chief Executive Officer within four weeks from today detailing the pending retiral dues which have not yet been received by him. The respondent no. 2, the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-the Chief Executive Officer upon

receipt of such representation would make payment of the entire retiral benefits and other dues of the petitioner within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of such representation and if any claim made by the petitioner is found not sustainable, the same should be rejected by a speaking order to be passed within the same stipulated period.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
