2. 18.9.2009 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

There is admitted dispute in between the parties.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that injuries received by the victim is not justifying intention to kill as those have been found simple.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from the date of communication of this order the above named petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga, in connection with Keoti P.S. case no.46 of 2009 , subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
