I.A. No.1959 of 2007 is a petition under Section 5 of Limitation Act for condoning the delay of two years and two months in filing of this M.J.C.

On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners/appellants and on consideration of the grounds given in the petition the delay is condoned but with a condition precedent that the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.500/- to the Patna High Court Legal Services Committee within one week. After condoning the delay this M.J.C. application which is for restoration of M.J.C. No.1647 of 2003 which itself was a restoration application for L.P.A. No.1278 of 2002 which stood dismissed on 01.08.2003 on account of non-prosecution of the L.P.A. as well as the limitation petition filed in the L.P.A, was heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the

appellants and on consideration of the grounds as set forth in the application, this restoration application is allowed. The M.J.C. No.1647 of 2003 will stand restored to its original file. It is hereby clarified that the pr45rocess of restoration will be taken up only after a deposit of Rs.500/- in the Patna High Court Legal Aid Services Committee within a week.
