Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner renews his prayer for bail from custody in a Police case under Sections 17, 21, 22, 25 and 27A of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The submission is that the allegations of recovery are from the shop of one Ram Pyare Chaudhary. He has been discharged in Trial No. 49 of 2005 on 7.11.2006 noticing that it could not be proved that the seized narcotic was heroin.

Co-accused has been granted anticipatory bail in Cr. Misc.

No. 6252 of 2005 after noticing the Forensic Science Laboratory report with regard to the seized powder like substance that no trace of heroin or any psychtropic drug was detected.

Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the District and Sessions Judge Cum Special Judge, Kaimur at Bhabua in Connection with Mohania P.S. Case No. 66/2004.
