

Moulik, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners came up with a prayer to allow the petitioners to withdraw the writ petition. A copy of the application filed by the petitioners in this regard has been served on the learned Government Advocate.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The main ground for seeking permission to withdraw the writ petition as mentioned in the petition is that the petitioners have been reinstated as Sanskrit post graduate teachers/graduate teachers on co-terminus basis in a separate scheme called 'Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan'. The petitioners also seek liberty to file a fresh petition, if so advised, in future. The learned Government Advocate has no objection if the petition is allowed subject to the condition that the petitioners shall have liberty to file a fresh petition only if law permits.</p> <p>In view of the above, the writ petitioners are allowed to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action if permissible under the law.</p> <p>This writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.</p> <p> ( Justice A.
