

Mr. Pankaj Sharma, Advocate, fairly submits that it would be in the interest of justice if the matter is remanded to the learned Special Court for disposal on merits. I find the stand to be appropriate as the case involves offences under the Prevention of Corruption Act which inherently has public element in it. The impugned order is accordingly set aside.</p> <p>3. Learned Special Court is directed to dispose the case expeditiously, keeping strictly in view the provisions of sub section 1 of Section 309, Criminal Procedure Code, 1973. It is expected that the C.B.I. which is generally found to be recalcitrant and not diligent in pursuing their cases, will co-operate with the learned Special Court for early disposal of the case.
