		instituted by respondent No. 1 herein as the plaintiff
		(hereinafter referred to as 'the respondent') for

declaration of a decree of specific performance to perform the agreement dated 19.09.2005 by directing the appellant herein (defendant No. 1 in the title suit abovementioned) to relinquish and resign from the post of the Managing Director of the Sikkim Distilleries Ltd., the respondent No. 2 herein, made the order of ad-interim injunction passed on 14.10.2008 in favour of the respondent absolute by ordering that the appellant, his nominees, agents and

representatives or any other persons under his instructions were restrained from transferring his or his nominees' shares of the respondent No. 2 to any third party. The appellant was further restrained from functioning as the Managing Director of the respondent No. 2 by the impugned order dated 19.02.2009.

Being aggrieved by such order of temporary injunction passed against the appellant, he has preferred the instant appeal and the same is awaiting for disposal.

Having thoroughly considered the issue raised herein that pertains to granting of temporary injunction against the appellant and also upon hearing the learned counsel for the parties at length on the issue itself at the order stage, we are of the considered view that interest of justice will be satisfied if the appeal is disposed of today itself at the order stage by sending the entire matter back to the original file of Title Suit No. 14 of 2008 pending before the learned District Judge, East and North Sikkim at Gangtok for final disposal at the earliest possible date.

Accordingly, the matter is sent down to the Court of the learned District Judge, East and North
