		This application filed under Section 227 of the
		Constitution of India is directed against the impugned
		judgment/award dated 24-02-2009 passed by the learned
		Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, South & West at
		Namchi in MACT Case No.11 of 2008.
		The only grievance raised by the Revisionist is that
		the amount of Rs.5,85,500/- as awarded by the learned
		tribunal was bad on account of the total annual income of
		the deceased having been taken as Rs.48,000/- instead of
		Rs.40,000/- as specified in the second schedule attached
		to the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
1		In the course of the hearing today the learned
		counsel for both the parties submitted at the bar that the
		respondents having accepted the position that there was
		mis-calculation by the learned tribunal, they worked out
		the amount as per the second schedule and on such
		calculation the amount comes to Rs.4,89,500/- without
		interest and Rs.5,62,925/- with interest calculated @10%
		from the date of application till date. Both parties have
	}	accordingly prayed for necessary modification for the
		award.
