The petition is filed with the prayer as follows :-

&..Your Lordships may be kind enough to admit this petition and issue Rule to the respondents to show cause as to why an appropriate interim order staying the appointment process of Assistant Teachers in Lower Primary and Upper Primary Schools initiated on the basis of the advertisement dated 01-12-2005 should not be passed, and after going through the show cause filed if any and hearing the parties be pleased to make the Rule absolute and/or pass such order/orders as Your Lordships may deem fit and proper.

Heard Mr. AM Mazumdar, learned senior counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. VM Thomas, learned State Counsel.

In the circumstances though we are not inclined to grant interim order, as prayed for, we make it clear that any appointment made pursuant to the advertisement dated 2-12-05, which is the subject matter of dispute in the present writ petition, shall be subject to the result of the writ petition.
